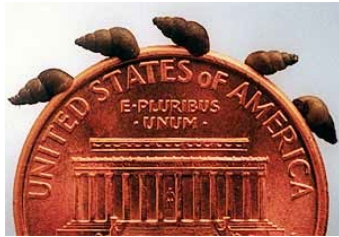


# STOP

## CLEAN YOUR WADERS TO PROTECT NJ TROUT STREAMS

### INSPECT

gear carefully.  
Snails hide in  
treads & socks

### TREAT

Remove debris.  
Rinse with  
potable water

### DRY

waders  
completely

Avoid using felt  
soled waders

Freeze waders for 24  
hours OR see website  
for other options

Dry for 72 hours before  
using in other streams
