CLEAN YOUR WADERS TO PROTECT NJ TROUT STREAMS

INSPECT

your gear carefully
Snails hide in treads
& socks

TREAT

Remove debris
Rinse with
potable water

DRY

waders
completely

Avoid using felt
soled waders
