

This past November, after years of research, transcribing and editing, the Historic Preservation Commission published "The Early Settlers of Holland Twp, NJ! Please click on the 'Early Settlers' tab for additional information.

Our project of dating historic barns with dendrochronology (or tree-ring dating) continues. Determining a precise date of four historic barns will add to an existing body of work that began with a township-wide barn survey. Dating barns will help to better understand the early settlement patterns and migration into the area that is now Holland Township. Please click on the 'Dendrochronology Research' tab for a detailed description of this project.

Work has started on a project to locate township sites of historic interest (e.g. houses, barns, taverns, ferries, abandoned roads) on an interactive Google Earth map. This is in cooperation with the Delaware Twp. Historical Society and other municipalities. The map is Countywide and will be available online.

Work continues on our survey of historic outbuildings and the documenting endangered historic houses.
