-ORDINANCE 2020-16-WITHDRAWN Public Hearing/Final Adoption - Easement between Sycamore and Elmhurst

Second reading and Public Hearing set for December 15, 2020 Introduction was Tabled at the November 4, 2020 meeting

ORDINANCE 2020-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTIES BY NEGOTIATION, PURCHASE

WHEREAS, there are two properties in Holland Township that have conditions which require the Township to acquire certain easements;

WHEREAS, during severe rain events, the current system is unable to handle the volume of water; and

WHEREAS, the inability to handle such high levels of flow jeopardizes the health and welfare of the residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, upon advice of the Township Engineer, the governing body of the Township has determined that installation of additional storm water piping would transfer the water to a different location by a gravity line improving public safety; and

WHEREAS, such gravity line must be constructed across certain residential properties designated on the Tax Map of the Township of Holland at Block 8.04, Lot 1; and Block 8.04, Lot 8; and

WHEREAS, the Township, therefore, requires temporary construction easements on the above-referenced properties for the purpose of access and construction of an extension of the storm sewer to benefit the Township and permanent storm sewer easements on the above-referenced properties for the purpose of maintaining, repairing and replacing storm sewer structures, which are more particularly described on Schedule A and B attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Township has attempted in good faith to negotiate the purchase of temporary construction easements for the purpose of access and construction of an extension of the sanitary sewer to benefit the Township and permanent storm sewer easements on the above-referenced properties for the purpose of maintaining, repairing and replacing storm sewer structures; and

WHEREAS, the Township has come to an agreement with the owners of Block 8.04, Lot 1; and Block 8.04, Lot 8; to purchase the easements for \$1.00; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee of the Township further find that a public use and purpose would be served for the benefit of the Township by acquiring certain property interests in the aforesaid properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Holland, the County of Hunterdon, as follows:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if specifically set forth at length herein.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and Committee of the Township of Holland, if advisable, specially authorize any and all necessary and appropriate actions by Township officials including the Mayor, Township Clerk, Township

Engineer, Township Attorney, in conjunction with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and/or any other appropriate State or Federal entity, for obtaining of certain property interests in the properties as set forth herein through negotiation, purchase, including, but not limited to, the hiring of any experts, engaging the services of land surveyors, title insurance companies, appraisers, and any other professional whose services are necessary or appropriate to implement the purposes of this Ordinance, the making of any offer by the Township to the property owner(s) in the amount of \$1.00 interest that the Township seeks to acquire in said property, and to negotiate in good faith with the record owner(s) of the property for its voluntary acquisition in accordance with N.J.S.A. 20:3-6, and in the event that the negotiations for the voluntary acquisition of the property interest are unsuccessful for any reason to commence a condemnation action by the filing of a Verified Complaint and Declaration of Taking, depositing the estimated just compensation with the Clerk of the Superior Court, filing a Lis Pendens, and taking any and all other actions of any administrative or other nature necessary to complete the process contemplated by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The portions of properties for which a taking of property interests is authorized by negotiation, purchase pursuant to this Ordinance are located in the Township and listed on the Township tax map, the legal descriptions of which are attached as Schedule A to this Ordinance and specifically incorporated into this Ordinance by reference. The property interests to be acquired are temporary construction easements and irrevocable, perpetual, permanent easements in the properties identified herein.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> All appropriate officials of the Township, including, but not limited, to the Mayor, Township Clerk, Township Engineer, Township Attorney, and any and all experts or others acting on behalf of the Township are authorized by this Ordinance to sign any and all documentation and take any and all action necessary to effectuate the purposes and intention of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> All appropriate officials of the Township, including, but not limited to, the Mayor, Township Clerk, Township Engineer, Township Attorney, are authorized by this Ordinance to sign any and all documentation to effectuate the purchase of the property interests by the Township.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed as to such inconsistencies.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

-ORDINANCE 2020-17- Public Hearing/Final Adoption-Purchase of Property within the Highlands Preservation Zone of the Planning Area of the Highlands Region

ORDINANCE 2020-17 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY DESIGNATED AS BLOCK 26, LOT 10

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland (the "Township") wishes to acquire approximately 68+/- acres of land designated as Block 26, Lot 10 on the Township Tax Map, located at 315 Riegelsville Road; and

WHEREAS, according to the Highlands Council, the Property is within the preservation zone of the planning area of the Highlands Region; and

WHEREAS, the Highlands Council allows the lot to be developed with a single family dwelling pursuant to an exemption available from Highland Regulation for a minor development as a single family dwelling or a minor subdivision into to lots as each would exceed 33 acres; and

WHEREAS, the Property lies within eight miles of I-78, a major east/west transportation artery providing linkage to employment, shopping and recreational facilities and residential development would be harmonious with neighborhood characteristics; and

WHEREAS, the Property is located in an area improved with scattered residential land uses and agricultural uses; and

WHEREAS, the maximally productive use of the Property as vacant and unrestricted, is for continued agricultural use and future large lot residential development; and

WHEREAS, Holland Township is in the process of applying for two grants to partially fund the acquisition and has obtained two appraisals for the subject property; and

WHEREAS, Holland Township has dedicated fund balances from previously collected Open Space taxes both at the County and local level that can be used as funds for this purchase; and

WHEREAS, Holland Township will endeavor to leverage its dedicated fund balances through additional partnerships with open space conservancy organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Township shall be required to reimburse certain costs up front such as for environmental testing, a survey, and title insurance costs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Local Land and Buildings Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-3, et seq., requires adoption of an ordinance to authorize the acquisition of 315 Riegelsville Road; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Holland, the County of Hunterdon, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Subject to the availability of funds described herein, the Township is hereby authorized to participate in the acquisition of the Property as referenced hereinabove provided that the amount does not exceed the per acre value that will be reimbursed by the county and that the Township is awarded matching funds from the County and/or other entities that is equal to or greater than 50% of the agreed upon purchase price.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The Deputy Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions and execute all necessary documents, including, but not limited, to the Purchase Agreement in substantially the same form as attached hereto, deed of conveyance, HUD-1 settlement statement, affidavit of title, and such other closing documents in order to authorize both the acquisition and conveyance of 315 Riegelsville Road.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as prescribed by law.

-RESOLUTION-hiring a Police Officer

RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Township of Holland to Hire One New Full-Time Regular Police Officer WHEREAS, in order to maintain the health, safety and welfare of the public at large, the Holland Township Committee has determined that it is necessary to hire a regular full-time police officer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32-4 of the Code of the Township of Holland (the "Code") the Holland Township Committee conducted interviews of various applicants; and

WHEREAS, the Committee and the Holland Township Police Chief have reviewed Matthew Decataldo's application, qualifications, background check, medical examination (pending), psychological examination (pending), Police Training Commission qualifications and have found them all to be acceptable; and

WHEREAS, the salary associated with this new hire shall be set at the Patrolman 13th Class sum of \$45,390.00 per year, in accordance with the "Agreement Between the Township of Holland and New Jersey Policemen's Benevolent Association Hunterdon County N.J. Local No. 188" ("PBA Contract") executed by the Township and the PBA Local 188 (the "PBA") on December 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the PBA Contract, this new hire will be considered probationary for a minimum period of twelve (12) months and shall be required to successfully complete a police basic training course, if required, within the time periods of applicable law prior to receiving a permanent appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has determined that there are sufficient funds available in the General Operations Municipal budget to pay for this employee.

WHEREAS, all other terms and conditions of employment relating to this new hire shall be as set forth in the PBA Contract and any subsequent agreements made between the PBA and the Township; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, that, effective January 1, 2020 Matthew Decataldo be appointed as a full-time Patrolman 13th Class, in accordance with Ordinance §32-4 at the salary of \$45,390.00 per year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the employment of this new hire shall be conditioned upon passing all applicable requirements set forth in the applicable ordinances, statutes, and regulations; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all appropriate Township officials are hereby authorized and directed to take all appropriate actions in furtherance of the intentions set forth in this Resolution.
