## BOARD OF HEALTH November 9, 2023

On Thursday, November 9, 2023, at 7:05 P.M., the regularly scheduled meeting of the Holland Township Board of Health was held in the meeting room at the Municipal Building, 61 Church Road.

Before the meeting was opened, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Audrey Balogh, and the following statement was read at the commencement of the meeting.

Adequate notice of this regular meeting was given pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, by the Township Clerk on December 8, 2022, by:

The following correspondence was given to members present.

Steve Parker was in attendance, representing Erica Busch, requesting Waivers for a septic system alteration with no expansion on an existing three bedroom dwelling.

- 1. The proposed disposal bed will be only 62 feet from the existing well, which does not meet the minimum set back requirement of100 feet. Since there is no well record or information on the well, the engineer has proposed an ultra violet device on the well and a passing water test for coliform after the treatment is installed.
- 2. The proposed septic tank will be only 32 feet from the existing well, which does not meet the minimum setback requirement of 50 feet. The 50 foot separation cannot be achieved since there would not be enough backfill cover over the tank.

Christopher Balogh made a motion to grant these waivers on Block: 1 Lot: 35, items 1 and 2. The Board is requiring the Ultra Violet device be put on the well and a passing water test for coliform after the treatment is installed. The motion was seconded by Ton y Szumski. A roll call vote was taken. Donna Lizanich, aye; Pearl Hammerstone, aye; Audrey Balogh, aye; Tony Szumski, aye; Christopher Balogh, aye and Duane Young, aye.
