-RESOLUTION-Tonnage Report

RESOLUTION

Authorization to Submit 2014 Tonnage Report and Grant Application

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L.198 7, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

WHEREAS, The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgated recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the 2014 Recycling Tonnage Grant will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of The Holland Township Committee to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

WHEREAS, such a Resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Holland Township Committee, Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon in the State of New Jersey that they hereby endorse the submission of the 2014 Recycling Tonnage Grant Application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Certified Recycling Coordinator, Alan Turdo to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the Recycling Tonnage Grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

RESOLUTION

Authorization to hire Robin Nugent as part time Summer Camp Supervisor Riegel Ridge Community Center

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Holland is in need of front desk staff at the Riegel Ridge Community Center, and

WHEREAS, according to the Chief Financial Officer, there are sufficient funds available in the General Operations Municipal budget to pay for this employee, and

WHEREAS, this employee will be hired as an "at will" 12 month part-time employee, with a six months initial probationary period, starting as of the date of hire; and

WHEREAS, this employee will be required to wear a uniform prescribed by the Township, portions of which may be furnished by the Township and portions will be furnished by the employee; and

WHEREAS, this employee will report directly to the Director of Parks and Recreation, and

WHEREAS, a current copy of the Holland Township Employee Handbook will be made available to this employee for review and will be required to comply with all policies in the handbook, and

WHEREAS, this employee will be required to attend and pass all required training; and

WHEREAS, this employee will be required to submit to all background checks required for their position, and

WHEREAS, Director of Parks and Recreation Jessica Neglia advises the Township Committee that until results of the background check have been received, this employee will be supervised at all times.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Holland Township Committee, Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon in the State of New Jersey, that Robin Nugent will be hired as Riegel Ridge Community Center as Summer Camp Supervisor at the 2015 rate of \$20.00 per/hr. contingent on favorable results of all required background checks, effective April 22, 2015.

-RESOLUTION-Dedication by Rider-Parking Offenses Adjudication Act

RESOLUTION

Dedicated by Rider

Requesting permission for the dedication by rider for Parking Offenses Adjudication Act (N.J.S.A. 39:4-139.9)

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-139.9 provides for receipts of Parking Offenses Adjudication Act (N.J.S.A. 39:4-139.9) by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the Parking Offenses Adjudication Act (N.J.S.A. 39:4-139.9) are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon, New Jersey as follows:

- 1) The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to pay expenditures of the Parking Offenses Adjudication Act (N.J.S.A. 39:4-139.9)
- 2) The Clerk of the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this Resolution to the Holland Township Chief Financial Officer to be sent to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$45,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND \$155,000.00 IN STATE AID FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO BELLIS ROAD SECTION 1 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOLLAND, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$200,000.00.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Holland, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

The sum of \$45,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund in the General Capital Account, and State Road Aid in the amount of \$155,000.00 for Improvements to Bellis Road SECTION 1 in the Township in the amount of \$200,000.00.

SECTION TWO:

The period of usefulness of the above project as defined by N.J.S.A. 40A:2-22 is at least 5 years.

SECTION THREE: The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Township in the amount of \$315,000.00.

at least 5 years.
